RE: Update on Reopening

We would like to update you on the reopening of Asbury Place. Since the positive COVID-19 test result on April 8, all Asbury Place staff and residents have continued to test negative. We are awaiting a few pending staff test results, but after speaking with the Health Department, these results will not affect the reopening of the dining room and salon, and the resumption of activities. These staff members did not have a direct exposure to residents or were not working.

As we continue to speak with public health officials as required, they have suggested that going forward we continue to follow the procedures that are recommended by the CDC and local health department, which are listed below.

- At this time, **residents who have been vaccinated or are unvaccinated do not need to quarantine because the exposure from staff to residents was NOT prolonged.**
- If a new case of a direct exposure occurs prior to May 5, then all residents and staff will continue testing every 3-7 days until there are no new cases for 14 days, and we will be considered to be in an outbreak and updated guidelines will be provided at that time.
- The dining room will reopen on Monday, April 26. This will allow the dining staff time to switch operations back to in-person dining.
- Group activities will resume on Monday, April 26.

Please continue to follow all precautions:

- Washing Hands Frequently
- Staying 6ft apart
- Wearing your mask
