Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

I regret to inform you that we were notified that one staff member in our licensed areas tested positive for COVID-19.

We have notified public health officials as required and continue to follow procedures recommended by the CDC and local health department. We are taking every step as recommended by authorities to contain the spread.

Precautions for Asbury Place at this time:

- All Asbury Place residents will be on a 14-day quarantine that will end on April 16<sup>th</sup> if there are no further positive cases.
- Family visits will need to be outside until one round of testing is complete and no new cases are found.
- After the first round of testing and there are no new cases, visitors will be required to wear full personal protective equipment during their visits until all residents are out of quarantine. PPE will be provided at the time of your visit.
- All residents in Asbury Place will be tested on Saturday, April 10<sup>th</sup>
- All staff working in Asbury Place will be tested on April 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Staff are required to wear full personal protective equipment for 14 days while working in Asbury Place.
- The dining room will close for 14 days and will reopen if there are no new cases.
- For medical appointments, providers will need to make the decision whether appointments should be rescheduled.
