Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

We would like to update you on the most recent positive COVID-19 test result we've had on campus. On April 8th we informed you of a positive test result of a staff person in our licensed areas. We have received back the first round of COVID-19 tests since then, and all Asbury Place staff and residents have tested negative.

After speaking with public health officials as required, they have suggested that going forward we follow the procedures that are recommended by the CDC and local health department, which are listed below.

- At this time, **residents who have been vaccinated do not need to quarantine because the exposure from staff to residents was NOT prolonged. Those who have not been vaccinated must quarantine for 14 days.**
- If a new case occurs prior to May 5th, then all residents and staff will continue testing every 3-7 days until there are no new cases for 14 days, and we will be considered to be in an outbreak and updated guidelines will be provided at that time.
- Visitors will be required to wear full personal protective equipment (PPE) during their visits through April 21st. PPE (surgical mask, gown and gloves) will be provided for your visit.
- All residents in Asbury Place will be tested again on Wednesday, April 14th and again on April 20th.
- All staff working in Asbury Place will be tested again next week.
- Staff are required to wear full PPE through April 21st while working in Asbury Place.
- The dining room will continue to be closed until April 21st and will reopen if there are no new cases.
- Regarding medical appointments, providers will need to make the decision whether appointments should be rescheduled.
