Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

I regret to inform you that we were notified that one staff member in our licensed areas tested positive for COVID-19.

We have notified public health officials as required by the local health department. We are taking every step as directed by authorities in response.

Precautions for Arborview and Strickland Place (excluding 600 hall) at this time:

- Family visits will be on hold until one round of testing is complete on all residents and staff, and no new cases are identified.
- If there are no new cases after the first round of testing for residents and staff, visitation may resume.
- All residents will be tested every 3-5 days for 14 days starting with the first round of resident testing on May 19th.
- All staff working in these areas will be tested every 3-5 days for 14 days.
- Staff are required to wear KN95 and face shields for 14 days.
- The dining room will close until one round of testing is complete on all residents and staff, and no new cases are identified.
- Activities will be cancelled until one round of testing is complete on all residents and staff, and no new cases are identified.
- For medical appointments, providers will need to make the decision whether appointments should be rescheduled.

Precautions for Asbury Place and 600 Hall after first round of testing:

- All Asbury Place and 600 hall residents will be on a 14-day quarantine that will end on June 1st if there are no further positive cases.
- No visits will be allowed indoors in these areas during this time. Outdoor visits will be allowed once one round of testing is complete on all residents and staff, and no new cases are found.
- Room trays will be provided for these residents for 14 days.
- Activities will be suspended for 14 days.
- Staff are required to wear KN95 masks and face shields at all time and when providing direct resident care, full PPE will be worn.
- All residents will be tested every 3-5 days for 14 days starting with the first round of resident testing May 19th.
- All staff working in these areas will be tested every 3-5 days for 14 days.
- For medical appointments, providers will need to make the decision whether appointments should be rescheduled.

I recognize that this is a frustrating situation for you as it is for us, particularly in light of our 99.98% vaccination rate for residents. We will update you once we received results from the first round of testing..
