Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

We would like to update you on the most recent positive COVID-19 test result we've had on campus. On May 19th we informed you of a positive test result of a staff person in our licensed areas. We have received back the first round of COVID-19 tests since then, and, thankfully, **all staff and residents have tested negative.**

After speaking multiple times with local public health officials over the last two days as required, they suggested that going forward we follow the procedures that were recommended in the last memo.

The guidelines from CMS, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid recommend that **residents who have been vaccinated do not need to quarantine as long as the first round of tests are negative. However, those who have NOT been vaccinated must quarantine for 14 days.**

Therefore:

- Family visits will resume as of 4pm on May 21, 2021
- All residents will continue to be tested every 3-5 days for 14 days
- All staff working in these areas will continue to be tested every 3-5 days for 14 days
- Staff are required to wear KN95 and face shields for 14 days
- The dining room will open back up May 23, 2021
- Activities will resume May 22, 2021
