In response to the positive COVID test results for four residents in Strickland Place, I met with the Resident Council Advisory Group on COVID-19 today to discuss the implications for our community. After a lengthy conversation, and out of an abundance of caution, we are implementing the guidelines listed below. For those of you with loved ones in our licensed areas, I have also included information regarding current restrictions in those areas.

<b>Independent Living</b>	<b>Strickland Place, Asbury Place and Arborview</b>
<p>Visitors in private homes are still welcome; however, they are not permitted in common areas such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lakeside, Arbor Room and the Book Nook. These areas will remain open to all residents with normal hours of operation.</li> <li>• Wellness Center</li> <li>• Other common areas</li> </ul> <p>Guests of residents in apartments are asked to go directly to the resident’s apartment and limit time in hallways and lobbies.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 300-400 halls of Strickland Place are on quarantine for 14 days starting August 11, 2021. The quarantine may be extended at the direction of the department of health in the event of additional cases.</li> <li>• Meals will be delivered to individual rooms in all licensed areas until directed otherwise by the department of health.</li> <li>• Group activities are currently curtailed until cleared by the department of health.</li> </ul>
<p>We are suspending the use of our facilities by non-residents.</p>	<p>Exterior doors will be locked at all times. Access can be granted by using the communication panels at the doors.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Live and Learn</b> will proceed as planned for the time being, but is limited to residents only.</li> <li>• <b>Pool classes</b> will be limited to nine individuals plus the instructor. Please contact Suzy Vaile at ext. 1227 or <a href="mailto:svaile@arboracres.org">svaile@arboracres.org</a> to reserve your space.</li> </ul>	<p>While visitation is not allowed in the 300 and 400 halls during the quarantine, all other areas may have outdoor visitation when scheduled through <u>Calendly</u>. A link will be provided to you directly from health care center staff.</p> <p>Licensed area residents will not be permitted in the independent living area of Arbor Acres, nor will independent living residents be permitted to enter the licensed areas.</p>

We ask that residents and guests wear masks indoors and continue to use good hand hygiene and maintain social distance. We ask that residents be extremely cautious when going outside the community where you are likely to encounter individuals who may not be vaccinated or masked. Please remain vigilant in your interactions and wear your mask. It is the best thing you can do to protect yourself and others.
