Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

I regret to inform you that we have four residents in our licensed areas and five staff members in our licensed areas who have tested positive for COVID-19. At this time, we will continue to be under quarantine requirements through August 29, 2021, however this date is subject to change if we continue to have additional positive cases.

We are taking every step as recommended by the local health department to contain the spread. At this time all residents on the 100, 500, 600 and 800 halls, as well as residents who live in Arborview and Asbury Place, have tested negative as of 8/16/21.

Precautions we are taking at this time:

- Visitation in Strickland Place is suspended for the 200, 300 and 400 halls through August 29th.
- For all other areas of care family visits will be outdoors only and will be scheduled through Calendly.
- All residents and staff will continue to be tested until the end of the quarantine period.
- Staff in the licensed areas are required to wear full personal protective equipment through the duration of the quarantine.
- The dining rooms and all activities will be suspended through the duration of the quarantine.
- For medical appointments, providers will need to make the decision whether appointments should be rescheduled.
