Over the past few days, a question has arisen regarding how long we plan to keep the moratorium on visitors in the common areas, including dining rooms, in place. In light of the current high rate of infections throughout our area, we have made the decision to continue to keep the restrictions in place for at least two weeks. At that time, the Resident Council Advisory Committee on COVID-19 and I will meet to review the most current state health department data to determine whether to continue, modify or lift this restriction. We are by no means out of the woods. We hope that the data will improve in the coming weeks.

On another topic, I want to inform families, guest and residents that with the current construction and the change in the traffic flow on our campus, we are placing a ban on curbside parking on Bayberry Circle. Please use the parking lot in front of Berrier or by the fence line across from the lake when entering the main buildings. This will support our efforts to mitigate any traffic congestion or potential accidents. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.
