As you know, we have been committed to keeping you informed each time we have a COVID-19 positive test result amongst our residents or staff. As you also know, these letters have become overwhelming and repetitive. Moving forward we are going to provide you with accurate information on active positive cases a little differently. We will update the Arbor Acres website (www.arboracres.org) COVID page once a week with the following data:

- Number of active staff cases
- Number of active resident cases
- % of staff vaccinated

Please check the website weekly for updates.

Please know that staff in our healthcare areas are still wearing N95's and face shields at this time, and will continue to do so until all staff are vaccinated and/or the county positivity rates decrease. We will continue to test all unvaccinated staff, and as needed, when a staff member or resident has a possible exposure to or signs/symptoms of COVID.

Additionally, I want to let you know that we have received new guidance from the CDC regarding quarantine requirements when there has been a possible exposure.

CDC Recommendations for Quarantine of Long Term Care Residents' Post Exposure:

- Unvaccinated - quarantine for 14 days even with a negative test
- Fully vaccinated do not need to be quarantined but should wear protective gear and be tested, unless symptomatic
- Residents with SARS-CoV-2 infection in the past 90 days do not need to be quarantined
