The words are compelling; the story is timeless. "... Mom is 103 years old and is an author, an artist, a nurse and a WWII veteran. She has led a fulfilling life but not one of wealth. In November 2020, she fell and broke her shoulder. My sister and I had to arrange for 24/7 care and by April of 2021 she had used up all her savings. The cost was very high and we were contributing thousands of dollars each month – just to keep up. We knew we could only continue for a few more months at that rate ...

... Then in June, we received an amazing scholarship offer from Arbor Acres. We

were able to move her into the best facility locally and arguably in the entire state. What a blessing! I think it is important for you all to see the effect of your work on a personal basis. My family was at the end of our rope with no place to turn, and your unbelievable generosity and belief in giving back to the community has turned all that around. Words cannot properly express our gratitude and we hope that all of you can experience a well-earned sense of pride and accomplishment for what you have done ..."

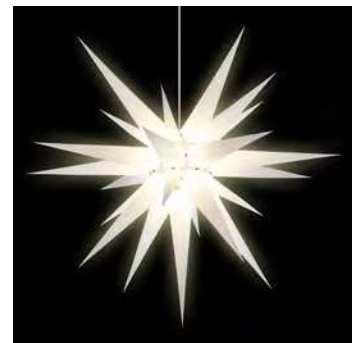

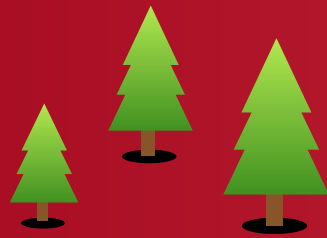

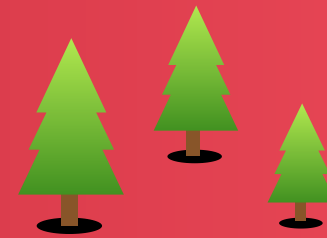
